SUBJECT: **Annexation a Portion of the West Rhode Island Right-of-way**

PURPOSE

To approve an ordinance that annexes a certain portion of right-of-way into the City limits of Orange City.

BACKGROUND

This right-of-way annexation is due to the fact that a goodly portion of West Rhode Island Avenue is already located within the City limits of Orange City. Having unincorporated rights-of-way lying adjacent to the City limits causes confusion with regard to police and fire jurisdictions and the provision of emergency services.

With this annexation, the City's intent is not to assume the maintenance responsibility of the street, but instead, to provide police and fire, and emergency services to the right-of-way, for the protection of life, safety, and welfare of the Orange City community and the public at large.

This memo and a phrase in the ordinance (the fifth Whereas) has been revised per input from the City Attorney. Attached is the annexation Ordinance, a property status report describing the property, and a map depicting the area proposed for annexation.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends City Council approval of Ordinance No. 359, thereby annexing the subject right-of-way into the City limits of Orange City.

ORDINANCE NO. 359

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ORANGE CITY, FLORIDA, ANNEXING A CERTAIN PORTION OF THE RIGHT OF WAY OF WEST RHODE ISLAND AVENUE INTO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ORANGE CITY, FLORIDA; IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ANNEXATION PROVISIONS OF FLORIDA STATUTE 171.044; REDEFINING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF ORANGE CITY BY AMENDING THE APPROPRIATE SECTIONS OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; CONTAINING A REPEALER PROVISION, A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes, Chapter 171, provides for the exclusive method of municipal annexation, in order to ensure sound urban development and efficient provision of urban services,

WHEREAS, it is the public interest for the City of Orange City to promote compact and contiguous provision of municipal services that further the protection of life, safety, and welfare of the community, and

WHEREAS, a portion of the right-of-way of West Rhode Island Avenue, as described herein, are bounded on one side by the City limits of the City of Orange City, and

WHEREAS, having unincorporated right-of-way such as the portion on West Rhode Island Avenue, as described herein, lying adjacent the City limits, causes confusion with regard to police and fire jurisdictions and the provision of other emergency services, and

WHEREAS, the intent of this ordinance is not to assume the maintenance responsibility of the aforementioned described street, but instead, to provide police, fire, and emergency services to that certain aforementioned described right-of-way, for the protection of life, safety, and the welfare of the Orange City Community, and

WHEREAS, the County of Volusia has stated they have no objection to such annexation, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORANGE CITY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The portion of right-of-way, generally located on West Rhode Island Avenue approximately 400 feet east of South Sparkman Avenue, containing approximately 0.759 acres, a description of which is attached hereto as Attachment "A", and by reference incorporated herein with full force and effect, is hereby annexed and made part of the City of Orange City, Florida, pursuant to Section 171.044, Florida Statutes.

SECTION 2. That upon adoption of this ordinance, the appropriate Sections of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Orange City shall be amended by redefining the boundaries of the City to include the lands described in Section 1.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk of the City of Orange City, Florida, is hereby directed pursuant to Section 171.044(3) of the Florida Statutes to comply with the public notification requirements for adoption of this ordinance, including sending a copy of the notice, via certified mail, to the County Council of the County of Volusia, and that upon adoption of this ordinance, certified copies shall be filed with the Clerk of the Circuit Court and the Chief Administrative Officer of the County of Volusia, the Department of State in Tallahassee, and the Office of the Governor, within seven days from the effective date of the ordinance, pursuant to Section 171.044.

SECTION 4. That upon this ordinance becoming effective, the property owners and any residents on the property described herein shall be entitled to all the rights and privileges and immunities as are from time to time granted to residents and property owners of the City of Orange City, Florida, as further provided in Chapter 171, Florida Statutes, and shall further be subject to the responsibilities of residence or ownership as may from time to time be determined by the governing authority of the City of Orange City, Florida, and the provisions of said Chapter 171, Florida Statutes.

SECTION 5. Repealer: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances and all resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, as well as any portion in conflict herewith.

SECTION 6. Severability: If any section, part of a section, paragraph, clause, phrase or word of this ordinance is declared invalid, the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall not be affected.

SECTION 7. Effective Date: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council of the City of Orange City, Florida.
