

**ORDINANCE NO. 361**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ORANGE CITY, VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA; CERTIFYING THE MILLAGE RATE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008-2009 ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY OF ORANGE CITY, VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA; CONTAINING A REPEALER PROVISION; A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

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**WHEREAS**, Florida Statutes 200.065 provides the City of Orange City shall adopt a millage rate to provide ad valorem tax revenue for governmental purposes for the 2008-2009 fiscal year; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager has delivered his recommended budget for said year in accordance with Article VII, Section 7.01 of the City Charter; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council has determined that to provide adequate services to the citizens of Orange City the millage rate for the fiscal year 2008-2009 shall be set at 4.48 mills which reflects a 5.71% decrease from the rollback rate of 4.7513 as provided by the Property Appraiser of Volusia County and does not reflect an increase in ad valorem taxes and;

**WHEREAS**, the first public hearing on the millage rate has been conducted by the City Council at 6:00 P.M. on September 9, 2008 and the final public hearing will be conducted on September 23, 2008, at 7:00 P.M. in the City Council Chambers at 201 N. Holly Ave., Orange City, Florida.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORANGE CITY, FLORIDA.**

**SECTION 1.** That the certified millage rate shall be 4.48 mills, for the purpose of realizing a sum sufficient to meet and defray the necessary ordinary running and operating expenses of the City of Orange City, Florida, for the year beginning October 1, 2008, and ending September 30, 2009.

**SECTION 2.** The final millage rate of 4.48 reflects a 5.71% decrease from the rollback rate of 4.7513 as certified by Property Appraiser of Volusia County and is below maximum millage rate for the City of Orange City and requires a simply majority vote for the 2008-2009 fiscal year ( Per s. 200.185(3)(a), F.S., as created by chapter 2007-321, L.O.F.).

**SECTION 3.** That the Finance Director shall notify the Department of Revenue, the Volusia County Property Appraiser, and the Volusia County Tax Collector of the millage rate.

**SECTION 4.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances and all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 5.** If any section, part of a section, paragraph, clause, phrase, or word of this Ordinance is declared invalid; the remaining provisions of the Ordinance shall not be effected.

**SECTION 6.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
