

RESOLUTION NO. 559-09

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORANGE CITY, FLORIDA, RESCHEDULING THE REGULARLY SCHEDULED MEETING OF SEPTEMBER 22, 2009; REPEALING ALL RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 80-1-1 provides that the City Council shall hold its regular meetings on the second and fourth Tuesday of the month at 7:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the second regularly scheduled meeting for the month of September 2009 falls on September 22nd, the same day that a City General Election is scheduled; and

WHEREAS, four City Council Members will be required to meet as the City's canvassing board on election day at 6:00 p.m. and will, therefore, not be able to attend the regular Council meeting; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to reschedule the second regularly scheduled Council meeting of September to Wednesday, September 23, 2009 at 7:00 p.m. during which meeting the City Council will certify the results of the September 22nd General Election; and

WHEREAS, the regular meeting schedule of the second and fourth Tuesday of the month will resume in October 2009.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORANGE CITY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the regularly scheduled meeting of September 22, 2009 is hereby rescheduled to Wednesday, September 23, 2009 at 7:00 p.m.

SECTION 3. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
