6. PUBLIC HEARING/SECOND READING

- A. **Ordinance No. 578** An Ordinance of The City Council of The City of Orange City, Florida extending the temporary moratorium within the jurisdictional limits of the City of Orange City relating to facilities dispensing medical marijuana; readopting findings of fact; prohibiting medical marijuana dispensing facilities during the extended moratorium period; directing staff to develop proposed land Development Code provisions and other recommendations regarding such dispensing facilities; providing for penalties, severability, conflicts, and an effective date.

7. RESOLUTIONS

- A. **Resolution No. 866-17** A Resolution of the City of Orange City, Florida, relating to the collection and disposal of solid waste in the incorporated area of Orange City, Florida; establishing the estimated assessment rate for solid waste service assessments against assessed property located within the incorporated area of Orange City, Florida, for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2017; directing the preparation of an updated assessment roll; authorizing a public hearing and directing the provision of notice thereof; and providing an effective date.
- B. **Resolution No. 867-17** A Resolution of the City of Orange City, Florida, relating to the provision of stormwater management services; estimating the cost of stormwater management services provided by the City; establishing the method of charging the cost of stormwater management services against the real property that will be benefited and served thereby; directing the assessment coordinator to prepare or direct the preparation of an updated stormwater service assessment roll based upon the methodology set forth herein; establishing a public hearing for the proposed stormwater service assessments and directing the provision of notice in connection therewith; providing for severability; and providing an effective date.
- C. **Resolution No. 868-17** A Resolution of the City of Orange City, Florida, relating to the provision of street lighting services, facilities, and programs throughout the shadow ridge street lighting assessment area; estimating the cost of street lighting services, facilities, and programs to be assessed for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2017; determining that certain real property will be specially benefitted thereby; establishing the method of assessing the street lighting service cost against the real property that will be specially benefitted thereby; directing the city manager to prepare or direct the preparation of a preliminary assessment roll based upon the methodology set forth herein; establishing a public hearing to consider imposition of the proposed street lighting assessments and the method of their collection and directing the provision of notice in connection therewith; providing for severability; and providing an effective date.
- D. **Resolution No 869-17** A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Orange City, Florida, adopting a proposed millage rate for the 2017-2018 fiscal year; establishing the date, time, and place for a public hearing on the proposed millage rate and the

tentative budget; directing communication; expressing legislative intent; repealing all resolutions in conflict herewith and providing for an effective date.

- E. **Resolution No. 871-17** A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Orange City, Florida, Volusia County urging members of the State legislature to adopt legislation amending current animal cruelty laws to impose stricter, harsher punishment and penalties for acts of animal cruelty.
