SUBJECT: Reappoint Robert Storke to Volusia Growth Management Commission

BACKGROUND:

The Volusia Growth Management Commission (VGMC) was formed by the Volusia County Council in 1987 to provide an effective means for coordinating the plans of cities and adjacent municipalities in Volusia County. The VGMC provides a forum for local intergovernmental cooperation and coordination. Robert Storke has been representing Orange City since 2009, and if reappointed will serve a term from July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2020.

RESOLUTION NO. 863-17

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORANGE CITY, FLORIDA, REAPPOINTING ROBERT STORKE TO THE VOLUSIA GROWTH MANAGEMENT COMMISSION (VGMC); REPEALING ALL RESOLUTIONS OR PARTS OF RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Volusia Growth Management Commission (VGMC) was formed by the Volusia County Council in 1987 following a public referendum that amended the County Charter in order to create the VGMC, and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the VGMC is to determine consistency between comprehensive plans for all governmental jurisdictions within Volusia County, consisting of the County of Volusia and all the municipalities.

WHEREAS, Section 202.3 of the Volusia County Charter states that there shall be one voting member from each municipality within the county and five voting members from the unincorporated area of the county. The appointment of each voting representative shall be made by the governing body of each respective jurisdiction, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City Council of the City of Orange City to appoint a representative to the VGMC; and

WHEREAS, Robert Storke has served on the VGMC since 2009; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council to reappoint Robert Storke as the City's representative to the Volusia Growth Management Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORANGE CITY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That Robert Storke is hereby appointed to be Orange City's representative on the Volusia Growth Management Commission (VGMC) for a term commencing on July 1, 2017 and to expire on June 30, 2020.

SECTION 2. That Robert Storke shall have all of the powers, duties and responsibilities set forth in the rules and procedures of the Volusia Growth Management Commission.

SECTION 3. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council of the City of Orange City, Florida.
