6. PUBLIC HEARING/SECOND READING

- A. **Ordinance No. 604** An ordinance of the City Council of the City of Orange City, Florida, changing the zoning classification for property located at 578 South Sparkman Avenue, consisting of approximately 2.5 acres, from low density residential (R-1) to rural residential (RR); repealing all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith and providing for an effective date.

7. RESOLUTIONS

- A. **Resolution No. 909-18** - A resolution of the City of Orange City, Florida, relating to the collection and disposal of solid waste in the incorporated area of Orange City, Florida; establishing the estimated assessment rate for solid waste service assessments against residential property located within the incorporated area of Orange City, Florida, for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2018; directing the preparation of an updated solid waste assessment roll; authorizing a public hearing and directing the provision of notice thereof; and providing an effective date.

- C. **Resolution No. 911-18** – A resolution of the City of Orange City, Florida, relating to the provision of street lighting services, facilities, and programs throughout the Shadow Ridge street lighting assessment area; estimating the cost of street lighting services, facilities, and programs to be assessed for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2018; directing the city manager to prepare or direct the preparation of an updated street lighting assessment roll; authorizing a public hearing and directing the provision of notice in connection thereof; providing for severability; and providing an effective date.
- D. **Resolution No. 914-18** A resolution of the City Council of the City of Orange City, Florida, adopting a proposed millage rate for the 2018-2019 fiscal year; establishing the date, time, and place for a public hearing on the proposed millage rate and the tentative budget; directing communication; expressing legislative intent; repealing all resolutions in conflict herewith and providing for an effective date.
