**SUBJECT:** Donation of Hydraulic Extrication Equipment

### BACKGROUND:

The Orange City Fire Department continues to replace equipment to keep current with changing technology and safety standards as it relates to the fire service. Recently, the old, "corded" hydraulic extrication equipment has been replaced through the budgetary process; and although this equipment has passed its industry standard for in-service life expectancy, it is still usable in a training environment.

Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 274, Florida Statutes, the City Council must declare surplus and authorize the disposal of all tangible personal property owned by the City of a non-consumable nature. Staff has received a request from Seminole State College for the outdated hydraulic extrication equipment to use in its fire training program.

### RECOMMENDATIONS:

Staff recommends that Council declare the extrication equipment surplus and approve the donation of this equipment to Seminole State College. This equipment would be used to train

future firefighters, create educational opportunities for our organization and foster community relations with a state educational facility.
