SUBJECT: Approve Resolution No. 935-18 Certifying the Results of the 2018 General Election

BACKGROUND:

In accordance with the provisions of the City Charter, a General Election was held on November 6, 2018, in the City of Orange City to elect qualified candidates to fill seats in Districts 4, 5, and At-Large. At the close of qualifying, Martin E. Harper was the only qualified candidate for District 5 and therefore was elected unopposed.

Incumbent Council Member Pupello was challenged for the District 4 seat by Kellianne Marks. Kellianne Marks was elected to the District 4 seat after receiving 60.29% of the vote. Gaea Nunez challenged incumbent O. William "Bill" Crippen. O. William "Bill" Crippen was re-elected to the At-Large seat after receiving 64.92% of the vote.

The results of the election were provided by the Supervisor of Elections, Lisa Lewis.

RESOLUTION NO. 935-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORANGE CITY, FLORIDA, DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF ORANGE CITY ON NOVEMBER 6, 2018; REPEALING ALL RESOLUTIONS OR PARTS OF RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, a General Election was held in the City of Orange City on November 6, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the results of said election, as provided by the Volusia County Canvassing Board were as follows.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORANGE CITY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The following candidates for the office of Orange City Council Member District 4 received the following votes in the General Election held in Precinct 303:

Anthony J. Pupello	<u>299</u>	<u>39.71</u>

Having received the majority of votes cast, Kellianne Marks is hereby declared the winner of the race for Orange City Council Member District 4 for the City of Orange City.

SECTION 2. That Martin E. Harper, having been duly qualified and running as an unopposed candidate for the office of Orange City Council Member District 5, is hereby declared elected.

SECTION 3. That the following candidates for the office of Orange City Council Member, At-Large received the following votes in the General Election held in Precincts 303 and 309.

Having received the majority of votes cast, O. William "Bill" Crippen is hereby declared the winner of the race for Orange City Council Member At-Large for the City of Orange City.

SECTION 4. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council of the City of Orange City, Florida.
