**SUBJECT:** Surplus Inventory

## BACKGROUND:

In September of 2011 the Police Department replaced all of its handguns. Although it has only been 7 years since the replacement of these handguns an opportunity to replace all the department handguns for only \$109.00 each (after a trade-in of our current inventory) is available. This trade-in opportunity has been available in prior years; however, it is unknown if this trade-in program will continue.

Historically we would wait until the handguns were ten years old before we looked at replacing them; however, currently we have sufficient funds available in our firearms/ammo line item to make the purchase this year.

The total amount to purchase 28 handguns with the trade-in would be \$3,052.00. Without the trade-in the purchase price would be \$11,452.00. This is a savings of \$8,400.00, which is \$109.00 per gun vs. \$409.00 per gun.

Pursuant to the provisions of chapter 274, Florida Statutes, the City Council must declare surplus and authorize the disposal of all tangible personal property owned by the city of a non-consumable nature. If declared surplus the city can use the department's current inventory of 28 handguns for the trade-in program as part of the new gun purchase.

**RECOMMENDATIONS:**

Staff recommends declaring the current inventory of 28 handguns as surplus thus allowing the city to use them as trade in property as part of the purchase.
