Section 4.04 and Section 4.03 of the City Charter requires that the City Clerk notify the Supervisor of Elections of any upcoming City elections and certify the form of ballot. Resolution No. 918-18 provides official notice and certifies the form of ballot to the Supervisor of Elections that a General Election will be held on November 8, 2018.

**RESOLUTION NO. 918-18**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORANGE CITY, FLORIDA, CALLING FOR A GENERAL ELECTION FOR COUNCIL MEMBER DISTRICT SEATS 4, 5 AND AT-LARGE TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 6, 2018; OFFICIALLY NOTIFYING THE SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS OF SAID DATE; AND CERTIFYING FORM OF BALLOT; REPEALING ALL RESOLUTIONS OR PARTS OF RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

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**WHEREAS**, Section 4.04 of the City Charter, "NOTICE Of ELECTION" provides that the City Council shall by Resolution, provide official notice to the Supervisor of Elections at least forty-five days prior to any regular or special election; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 4.03 of the City Charter, "FORM OF BALLOT" provides that the City Council shall by Resolution, list candidates for Mayor and Council members seats.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORANGE CITY, FLORIDA:**

**SECTION 1.** That the City of Orange City Florida shall hold a General Election on Tuesday, November 6, 2018 to fill the expiring seats for City Council Districts 4, District 5 and the At-Large District seat;

**SECTION 2.** That at the close of the legal qualifying period, noon June 18, 2018 through noon June 22, 2018, the candidates listed below have fulfilled the requirements necessary to qualify to have their names placed on the ballot for the 2018 Orange City General Election;

**SECTION 3.** That the duly qualified candidates for the District 4 seat are listed below:

**COUNCIL MEMBER DISTRICT 4**

Anthony J. Pupello  
Kellianne Marks

**SECTION 4.** That the duly qualified candidate for the District 5 seat is Martin E. Harper. Since this candidate is uncontested, he shall be deemed elected and his name shall not appear on the ballot.

**SECTION 5.** That the duly qualified candidates for the At-Large District seat are as listed below:

**SECTION 6.** That the City Clerk shall send a copy of this Resolution to the Supervisor of Elections, Volusia County, Florida, as the notice of election and certification of the form of ball for the election set forth herein.

**SECTION 7.** That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 8.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council of the City of Orange City, Florida.
